





The fruit of the gospel will be more abundant because of the Tree of Life you plant!




We will open seven parks in the "Life Blooming Garden" and plant a distinctive kind of flower tree in each park, with a total of 280 trees. We strongly encourage 280 people with the aspiration for Missions to join the "Tree of Life Mission Project".



We encourage you to sign your name and engrave a heartfelt missionary message on the copper plate next to each tree. In other words, 280 participants can each share a message of spiritual wisdom. In addition to supporting today's ministry, this project will leave a collective missionary testimony for future generations.



Imbued with strong missionary aspirations in the “Tree of Life”, the participants will pass it onto their family members, or in the church community, allowing such passion to generate a burden for future Missions. With the passage of time and the growth of trees, each "Tree of Life" will flourish and become a permanent memorial.





Every spring, the trees are full of flowers, and the scenery of the “Life Blooming Garden” is beautiful and captivating. In the summer, the trees are lush and luxuriant, bringing breeze and shade. In autumn, the leaves fall with grace and beauty, and the autumn colors are even more brilliant. In the future, we will hold regular family events and make it a place people will love to visit.



We will set up several prayer rooms in the parks for personal, quiet, and spiritual purposes. There will also be a small chapel in each park, allowing several families to come together to hold family gatherings, to encourage one another, and to build a godly and happy family together. At the same time, we will set a theme for each park, especially the theme of caring for groups with different needs.

How to participate:

Participants can donate \$15,000 to plant a tree of their own choice or the full amount can be divided into 5 separate donations of \$3,000 for five years. The flowering trees planted will be provided by the estate. No annual payment for maintenance or other expenses are required, but free donations and support are also welcome.

Magnolia trees bloom at the turn of spring and summer, and the flowering period is from April to May.



B. Ginkgo Tree

Theme: New Youth Immigrants

According to the annual growth pattern of Ginkgo trees, the trees are golden and dazzling in the autumn.



C. Kanzan

Theme: Families with Special Children

Kanzan trees bloom from late March to mid-April.



D. Crabapple

American crabapple trees bloom in the spring;
please choose either white or pink.

Theme: Single (Unmarried)



E. Hawthorn

Theme: Caring for the Family

Hawthorn trees have white flowers in the spring (left) and red fruits in the autumn (right).



F. Eastern Redbud

Theme: Caring for Elders and Artists

Eastern Redbuds bloom in April and May every year;
first flowering and then leaves.



G. Flowering Dogwood

Theme: Prayer Zone

The flowering period of Flowering Dogwood is from May to June, and the fruiting period is from August to October. Please choose either white or pink.
